

Prestwick Airport Jan 2024

Updates

This document contains the passenger numbers for each route that operated from Prestwick Airport in January 2024, as well as outlining how each route has performed compared to 2019 (we are using 2019 rather than 2020 as it will allow a complete year of statistics that have not been impacted by Covid-19).

Any country or route that was not served in 2024, but was served in 2019 will be highlighted in a separate list at the end of this document (routes that have been launched and since dropped between 2019 and 2024 will also be included).

Some routes may only be slightly above 2019 levels, which can be caused by their being less days in 2024 vs 2019. If a route operated every Monday in both years, the discrepancy could be caused by their being one less Monday in 2019.

Portugal

Faro: Operating above 2019 levels, 1225 more passengers than 2019

Spain (Mainland)

Alicante: Operating above 2019 levels, 724 more passengers than 2019

Malaga: Operating above 2019 levels, 164 more passengers than 2019

Spain (Canary Islands)

Lanzarote: Operating above 2019 levels, 1730 more passengers than 2019

Tenerife: Operating above 2019 levels, 728 more passengers than 2019

The following routes operated in January 2019, but did not operate in January 2024

- Fuerteventura (Spain)
- Malta (Malta)
- Rzeszow (Poland)

The following routes were launched and subsequently dropped between 2019 and 2024
(**PLEASE NOTE:** Some of these routes may have been converted to operate during summer months only!)

- Gran Canaria (Spain)
