Key Statistics About Dutch Tourists

- 4th Largest international inbound market to Scotland by visitors
- 7% of overseas tourists to Scotland are Dutch
- Dutch tourists contribute 5% of overseas tourism spending
- Numbers of Dutch tourists are above pre-pandemic levels



- Flights between Scotland and Amsterdam were operated by both easyJet and KLM, with Eindhoven being operated by Ryanair.
- Edinburgh Airport had the largest % of the market, but did not have the majority.



- Glasgow Amsterdam = 380,548


